Unlike my previous dogs, he had a different character and properties. Due to his driving potential Goyar demanded of me training within the extreme concentration.

Here Edgar Scherkl was a big help again. He helped me to built some things up, when Goyar was 1 ½ year old. And I helped Edgar with his “Cayman”, because both dogs had the same age. 😊

In August 2007 we made the IPO1, in September the IPO 2 and in November two times the IPO 3.



The first competition comes in the spring 2008. Goyar was just 3 years old and we participate at the pre-qualification for the FCI WC.

There he showed a very good performance with an impressive protectionwork.



Then in August followed the qualification for the FCI WC ...



... and in September the dHV Nationals.

It has now shown that this dog is extremely difficult to handle. Due his enormous drive-potential, he stays often himself in the path. Coupled with the motivation to do everything right, sometimes this leads to over-jump acts and impropriety.

As a handler for this dog is only one rule: Stay calm.



In 2009 we participate again at the pre-qualification for the FCI WC. But there we were not allowed to qualify for further championships.

So we started in September on the government championships, reached the 2nd place and after that we participate in November on the state championships. There we reached the 16th place of 60 participants.

In April 2010 we reached the 3rd place at the government championships and are qualified for

the state championships in September. So I gave up a possible start at the DVG Nationals. Because of the incidents the last year I was no longer interested to participate there.

At the end of September 2010 we started at the state championships and reached the 8th place of 28 participants. With this very good result we would have expected to qualify for the DVG Nationals. But I have decided again not to participate. Although my work with Goyar led to a significant improvement in all departments. But still Goyar is here and unfortunately there quite unstable. Because of his temperament I can't see a further increase.

The other reason is that I (and many other people) don't understand some things. It seems that quality, intensity, temperament, behaviour a. s. o. is not longer in demand. My opinion is that it must be judged. This could also be viewed from different perspectives. But please in the same way to all participants. Of course you can only count if you see some mistakes. Instead of getting angry about it constantly, I prefer to finish the whole thing. So I decide to finish the work with Goyar. When it became known that I no longer wanted to work with Goyar, there were also quite a few inquiries and offers. But I could never think about the idea to leave Goyar to a handler, who wants him to use only for sport. I did not want that someone is trying to supposedly "better training methods" at the dog and underestimates him.



I thought that Goyar would be good for the breeding, because of his very interesting bloodline and its extraordinary working abilities. So I was waiting for someone who wanted to use him only for this purpose. Again, there were some interested people.

He has left us in November 2010 and the new owner promised to take him only as a stud dog. It was a real shock, when we only 2 months later have heard that he had to be euthanized, because "*in training*" he has more often let shown "*the abnormal walk*".

Information:

When Goyar had the x-ray-investigation about the hips and elbows, I also let x-ray his back. In Germany only the hips and elbows are evaluated formally. But I've send also the x-ray photos of his back and they are kept at the DMC. They showed that time in the assessment by the x-ray-veterinary no abnormalities. His statement was: "Hurray, here we have the skeleton of the month..." He told me at that time in particular, that each vertebra had an optimal distance to the other.

The physical efforts of the state championship, like running, jumps, etc. Goyar completed without any problems. Alone in the protection work, he prepared the helpers (as usual) trouble. Not only because of this, one week after the state championship, Goyar was routinely checked by a professional veterinary for bones and movement.

So I handled it since Clip and T-Rex at the end of the season all the time. Because twice I had to do with sprained or twisted neck, lumbar vertebrae, which they had brought in the protection work.

The investigation was normal. So far **Goyar was perfectly healthy.**

Also on the day of the sale I have shown at home in our garden Goyar's ability and capability in parts of obedience- and protection work to the new owner. And also his character to react with more active even with light impacts. He showed no physical defects or deficits. Why should he? Finally, I had no longer worked with him for the last 2 months.
