Particularly in the defence work I had to pay attention to many little things; the structure at that time in this department was not optimally coordinated with his characteristics and was subjected to some misconceptions..



"T-Rex" did his first IPO 3 at the government championship in 2003 (2nd Pl.), then followed the state championship (5th Pl.).

He should make his third IPO 3 then on dHV-DM 2003, but one day before he "must" hurts himself by a totally unnecessary and stupid mistake of the self-esteem suffering helper.

Thus with a broken breastbone no participation was possible.



After a break of 8 weeks and only unique training he could shine then however with the IPO 3 and 294 points. Again a confirmation for me that founded basis training is valuable.

The reward for this was the qualification and subsequent participation at many national championships.

Additionally "T-Rex" existed the FH 1 with 100 points and the FH 2 with 96 points.
